We have been having ex-offenders calling selling items door to door in the Parish.

The one last Thursday became very nasty with me and when I spoke to our community policemen, there had also been another complaint.

The Trading Standards officer at Oxford County Council is sending me some labels which people can put on their doors saying no traders to call. If they then try to sell their wares, that is a criminal offence.

People can call 999 or, if the person has left, call 101.

These people show their identity cards, but they do not have peddler's licenses, so are selling illegally anyway.
