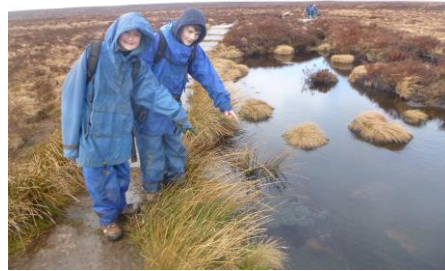


Dear Parents and Carers,

## **HOME LEARNING and SCHOOL OPENING**

We have sent home packs of learning for all children, we have put lots of website links on the home learning sheet – there are hundreds of books available and activities on line – please use them. The books are for writing / completing tasks etc. By the end of this period if the children could learn to spell the key words sent and know their tables (different levels for classes). We have also sent home handwriting for most classes – this is a priority area. We appreciate that this is difficult for parents – the work sent will cover the first 2 weeks then you have 2 weeks of the Easter Holidays. If we remain shut then we will be sending additional materials and looking at using Google classroom (this may include lending lap tops). Please remember that staff are working really hard to keep the school going as well as providing home learning and keeping themselves well. We have sent class emails to everyone so please use them for advice and support.

Additional things will be coming out – we will put things on the website – there will also be a weekly newsletter. We will also organise book swaps etc. in the coming weeks.

The school will be open from next week to vulnerable pupils and those of key workers however you need to book them in and agree this provision with school –do not just turn up. We have contacted most people about this so please contact us urgently if you fall into this bracket. We will be joining up with several other schools to provide this service.

The National Trust has opened all of their parks and open spaces – these sites are free of charge.

It is with huge sadness that I close the school to everyone – it would not have been my choice but I have to follow government advice. I wish you all well – please keep safe – much love to you all and your families
