

Statutory assessment points in primary schools

These are tests that are set by the government. We have to take part in them and report them to the DFE and Oxfordshire County Council. The school uses other assessments to support teacher assessments. These include informal and formal tests – they are done within class and with minimal stress. We do not expect children to practise for them as they are checking teaching and learning.
